


PINING FOR: a gigging and recording bassist NOVEL APPROACH: has always written with an album in mind; recently decided to just try writing songs to write songs, then sort which ones to bring to the band, which ones to keep for themself, etc. and assemble them into albums

WRITER'S BLOCK: Corpses of Castles took over a year to create (much longer than usual); DAN struggled to come up with lyrics for it and distracted themself by writing and recording Value and Meaning. They got several friends to play on the album, which they haven't done in a while.

UNION: BRANDON saw KYLE play keys in another band at a show in Jamesburg and asked him to join. KYLE and ANDY went to school together; when the original drummer dropped, KYLE introduced BRANDON to ANDY and they invited him to join the band.

NAMESAKE: BRANDON's surname

CHANNELS: The Smiths, The Cure, Radiohead, Type O

Negative, Oasis, Underoath

IDEATION: one person usually writes a song on their own and brings it to the band; they learn it at practice and flesh it out together, and BRANDON writes the lyrics

REIFICATION: Recorded their album at Carriage City Studio run by EJ GAUB. Started with a live set with instruments and a scratch vocal, then recorded final vocal and harmonies. Once they had a live recording roughly mixed, KYLE added MIDI, soloing, and samples (e.g. from Night of the Living Dead). He likes to create EDM-style drops with rock instrumentation.

ADVERTISEMENT: each song on the album is different; it's got hard stuff, slow stuff, and folkier stuff DECOR: year-round halloween

VISUAL AID: BRANDON likes to take the reins for music videos, aided by his housemates, the band, and other friends. "I Curse Dead Stars" was all DIY, "Snow Witches" was shot on film, and the upcoming "Good Luck" is like an '80s horror movie recorded on VHS\* and features GINA, who is on the album cover

DOGMA: horror \*Extremely Dilute Medicine \*Very Hosty Surgery
RECENT WORKS: Motherway, I Curse Dead Stars (EP)
LIKELY NEXT MOVES: releasing new music video,
recording new tracks, experimenting with more

CONVERGENCE: CHASE was jamming with a friend and needed a bassist; a mutual friend introduced him to CASSIDY. Together they formed the band with CHASE on drums and CASSIDY on bass. They had a number of guitarists but none of them stuck; a year ago, CHASE decided to learn guitar and they posted a drummer wanted flyer on Instagram. JAKE responded to the ad and joined on drums.

RECOMBINATORY ETYMOLOGY: They booked their first few shows without a band name; CASSIDY was listening to The Velvet Underground and suggested "The Velvet Dresses." CHASE was listening to Strange Days by The Doors; they stuck the names together to become Strange Velvet.

THROWING: sometimes CASSIDY and CHASE have song fragments that they merge and flesh out collaboratively; other times they all write together during rehearsal

PIT FIRING: originally they recorded in CHASE'S bedroom and pieced songs together layer by layer; they recorded "Nuclear Son" in a studio; recently they have been recording live tracks in the garage they rehearse in, then adding vocals ACCELERANT: wanted to write a rock-heavy album; started writing about things that make them angry DOGMA: feeling stuck, shitty love songs RECENT WORKS: Five Fast Songs (EP), "Power Trip" LIKELY NEXT MOVES: working on a new album, releasing new singles, adding a keyboardist UPCOMING SHOWS: May 8th, 2025 at Booksmiles
