MIKE and his cousin were interested in the story, so they decided to form a band and start playing the songs again.

IMPETUS: they received a series of cassette tapes that had some information about the future in 2045 (not too far away); the only way they could spread the message they've been trusted with is through their songs

NAMESAKE: a warning signal to stop the path we are currently on; also an entity that will arrive on earth

PRAXIS: WYATT usually writes a song on guitar and brings it to the rest of the band, then they write parts. Lately MIKE and ANDY have been more involved with writing

FACTUS: MIKE recorded their first album in the basement of their old house; WILL MILLER from Red Water Recording recorded their latest EP DOGMA: anti-technology, fear and panic, creating physical things and going outside while you still can

GROWTH: Philly is full of great bands, so JON and JOHNNY thought it was time for a really great band and formed a 2-piece noise act. They played one show and it was terrible and embarrassing. Then they brought CARLA in, she played some shows, and they said, "this might just work out after all." NOT A: finger is touching this neck unless it's a fun noise

BIG INTO: Big Black, Butthole Surfers, The Residents, Ween, Haruomi Hosono, meme music ACTION: They jam a lot. Sometimes one of them will come to practice with a song; sometimes one of them will send a bunch of song ideas into the groupchat, and instead of saying "I don't like it" they just don't say anything, so it makes everyone else in the band feel like they don't care, and then they go to practice and come up with an even worse song, and that's the one that gets recorded; sometimes two of them will pick out a third member and neg them very hard, and block their number, and make it so they can't log into the Instagram, and do that for a week or two until they're right on the edge, about to quit, then say, "no, no, oh my god, we love that idea, what are you doing?" DEVICE: TASCAM Portastudio 4-track cassette recorder operated by JON DOGMA: jokes that have become real songs MESSAGE FOR US: "So many bands are either trying to be cool, or are too nervous to even try to be cool, or are trying to be nonchalant but just come off as

DECOR: leftist propaganda and plants CLASSIFIED TECHNOLOGIES:


