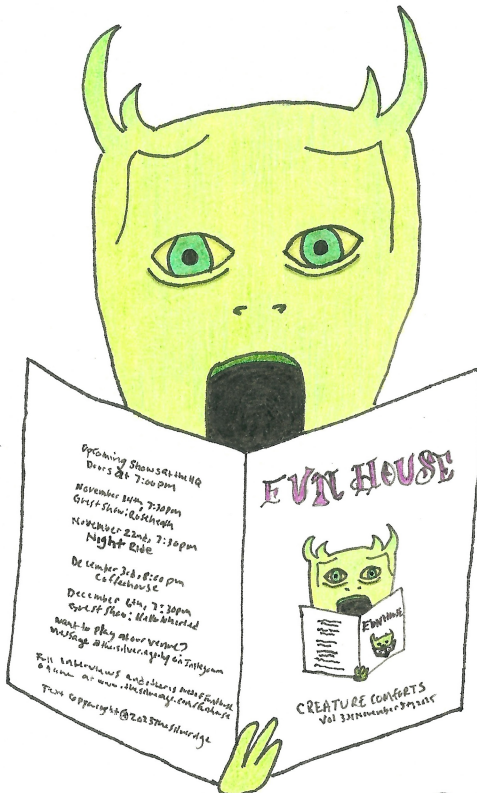

SPECIES: indie rock, folk
