

become better than him

MOTIVE: he was never good at anything else

#### EVAN

WEAPON OF CHOICE: bass

AKA: BUGCATCHER

EARLY LIFE: dad played drums and uncle played quitar; started on quitar, then switched to bass MOTIVE: doesn't know what he'd do if not music

#### RYAN

WEAPON OF CHOICE: keys

EARLY LIFE: played a piano in a department store

once; thought it was cool and kept playing

MOTIVE: it's the only thing he's ever done that

makes him feel like he makes sense

#### SID

WEAPON OF CHOICE: drums

EARLY LIFE: started playing drums at age 2 when his dad bought him a drum set; played in church MOTIVE: was good at sports, but he was too short HATCHING: EVAN and RYAN knew each other; EVAN joined a band called Hogarth with ALAN. They were called to do a show, but two of the members couldn't make it, so ALAN picked 7 or 8 songs that didn't fit Hogarth's vibe and decided to call themselves Swansun for the night.

UNFORESEEN CONSEQUENCE: ALAN just thought "Swanson" sounded cool and changed the spelling, but did not expect to be asked about it for the next five years FLAVORS: The Beatles, King Gizzard & the Lizard Wizard, Yes, Led Zeppelin, Black Sabbath, Snarky Puppy, Bob Dylan

THOUGHT PATTERNS: Usually someone brings an idea to the band and they build it up together. ALAN has written most of the songs so far; once he has a cool musical idea, he'll name it something and let that inform what the song is about, then write as many verses as he can think of and whittle it down to the most memorable lines.

STRATA: Their first album was recorded in a music school and tracked live; the second was recorded by CHRIS DOMS in his home studio and tracked individually. The current album is being recorded after hours in the recording studio where RYAN works and tracked live.

DOGMA: loneliness, alienation, murder, normal stuff RECENT WORKS: "Grapefruit," "Loving Vincent," It's Not Adding Up

LIKELY NEXT MOVES: dropping singles; psychological operation to control the public consciousness; working on album 3, to come in 2026

EARLY LIFE: started with cello in 4th grade, then upright bass in middle and high school

ROLE: architectural historian

MOTIVE: it's a great outlet; it's his way to be

a part of something

ACQUAINTANCE: ROBIN and SPENCER were dormmates in freshman year and played in Bird Furniture; SAM dated a former member of Bird Furniture; ERIK used to live in The Kitchenette before ROBIN Oktobenette pht KENNING: ROBIN wrote all his aesthetic ideas for the project down, combined pieces of words until he found a name that matched what was in his head and looked typographically good, then gave himself a tattoo of it

INITIAL CONDITIONS: Radiohead, Big Thief
PRINTING: ROBIN will have an idea and bring it to
the band, then they'll develop it into a live
version; when it's time to write an album, ROBIN
will spend more time on his own with the songs and
fill out the arrangements, then everyone relearns
the new versions; each album corresponds to an era,
and the songs within it thematically relate to each
other

BINDING: Material And Chemical was recorded at JULIA FINEGAN's house; they wanted to do as much live as they could, so ROBIN made a booklet of the lyrics and chord changes, spent a few months rehearsing with a 10-piece version of the band, and then tracked it in about two days. "Cargo Train" is a recording from outside The Kitchenette of a cargo train making a turn just south of the Schuy Kill River Viaduct.
