LOCUS OF ACQUAINTANCE: Maax Power and the Children of God

GENESIS: Initially gen/loss was SAM'S solo project. They were all hanging out on Stupid Baby's front porch at a Maax Power show when SAM suggested that MAX and ANDREW improvise over the music at his first show. Immediately the band formed; they had been playing and improvising together for over a year, so they already had good chemistry. They

didn't even rehearse all together for early shows. IMITATION: electronic and classical. minimalist composers, jazz, slop content SIGNIFICATION: stylization of "generation loss," in line with themes of degradation over time and copies of copies; the slash was inspired by :zoviet\*france:, an early influence @michaelrag.jpeg LOGOGRAM: designed by SAM's roommate, Mike Ray; wanted it to look like a ritualistic glyph in some language, based on a mashed together "g" and "l"; went through many revisions AUGMENTATION: SAM is constantly writing track skeletons and rough sketches of textures; SAM and ANDREW meet up regularly to go through them and expand on whatever is promising; then they take it to MAX and flesh it out more TOOLS: Ableton, TouchDesigner, Max/MSP, Pure Data, Blender, a multi-gigabyte library of samples of MAX PERMANENCE: "Over/Out" was a conventional band recording with a track for each person's part; "Untitled (Take 1)" was recorded by SAM and ANDREW, then put through an elaborate production process including dubbing to cassette and adding drum samples DOGMA: flesh, meat, cold, alien, wet, skin on skin on skin on skin RECENT WORKS: "Untitled (Take 1)" @ music video, "Over/Out" LIKELY NEXT MOVES: EP release, album release,

ACCESSIBLE VIA: 43 bus


